Please join us on Tuesday, **January 15, 2019**, for our monthly Alaska Chapter ASSP luncheon meeting at the BP Energy Center.

The guest speaker is **David R. McCallister**, *M.Sc.*, *CSP*, *CHMM*. He will be leading a presentation that details and provides actual examples of how a safety professional can impact the safety culture and performance of the company – working at the top of the organization with the corporate Sr. Leadership team and Sr. Leaders of contractors. This goes beyond compliance and standards, but safety leadership at the top levels of the company, use of risk registers to understand and mitigate risk, and getting at the hearts and minds of 1st line supervisors and workers.
